Question: Does the Bible teach evolution of any form?

Answer: NO! The Bible claims that, "*In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth*" (Gen 1:1).

The balance of the inspired writing sets out to prove this truth. The power of God's spoken word is shown in the creation, for He spoke it into existence (Ps. 33:6, 9). It is by faith that we understand and accept the fact that "*the worlds have been framed by the word of God*" (Heb. 11:3), to which we have access today (Rom. 10:17).
