

**DAVID L. LIPE** 

David L. Lipe holds an A.A. degree and third year certificate from Freed-Hardeman University; a B.A. from Harding University, an M.A. from Harding School of Theology, a Ph.D. from The University of Tennessee, and an M.S. from The University of Memphis. Lipe has been preaching since 1967 in Mississippi, Tennessee, and Alabama and been involved in mission campaigns in five foreign countries. He holds a number of gospel meetings each year and gives lectures on other occasions.

He is author of Values in Thought and Action and Religious Versus Secular Ethics—A Religious Response to Some Contemporary Secular Views of Ethics. He is co-author of the Lipe-Lewis Debate and Instrumental Music--Faith or Opinion. His 2-volume commentary in the Truth for Today Commentary Series, The Gospel of John is available for purchase from him or through Resource Publications. He has been the editor of the following lectureship books: Magnolia Bible College – 2 books; International Bible College – 1 book; Southeast Institute of Bible Studies – 7 books; Freed-Hardeman University – 22 books.

From 1990 to 2010 he was a professor of Bible and Philosophy at Freed-Hardeman University and continued to serve as the Director of the Annual Bible Lectureship through the 2015 lectureship. In 2012 Lipe became the Director of the Southeast Institute of Biblical Studies (formerly East Tennessee School of Preaching and Missions) in Knoxville, TN; he retired as director in December 2014 but continues to teach and work in fund raising and development for the school. Lipe and his wife, Linda, reside in Baxter, Tennessee; he preaches for the Cherry Creek Church of Christ in Sparta, Tennessee.

# Clean, Entirely!

There was a day, many years ago, when my children agreed to wash my car. I got them set up with a bucket of soapy water, sponges, towels, and a step stool to be able to reach all the way to the top. Then I gave them detailed instructions on how to wash a car and get it completely clean. It didn't take long before I had to stop what I was doing and go out and put an end to a water fight. I knew this would happen so I wasn't too shocked or upset. However, I did inform them that they hadn't washed the entire car and they were already rinsing it off. "This one side is still dirty," I said. To this my son replied, "But I already washed that side."

When we come to Christ we come to him covered, filthy, and spotted with sin. Isaiah spoke of this when he said, "Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool" (Isaiah 1:18).

We understand that the only way to be clean again is to be washed in the blood of the Lamb. The Lord has given us clear instructions on how this takes place. Obviously, we contact His blood in and through His death. Jesus said, "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved..." (Mark 16:16). Paul wrote, "Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:" (Romans 6:3-5).

Just as the blind man received his sight when he had washed in the Pool of Siloam (John 9), so we are washed when we obey Christ in baptism. In 2 Corinthians 6, Paul says that the brethren there had once been covered in sin but that they had been washed, sanctified and justified "in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God" (v. 11). Hebrews 10:22 states that we should "...draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water." Now it is not the condition of the water, but the pure blood of Christ that we contact in baptism that has the power to cleanse. In Revelation 1:5 we are told that Jesus "loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood." And 2 Peter 2:22 says that those who fall away are like unto "the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire."
