The Lamb's Bride (Revelation 21:9)

Jesus, the Son of God, came into this world to do one thing. Luke 19:10 says, "For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost." From the beginning of time the Father had a plan that would save mankind from death and offer redemption to all who would submit themselves to His Son (2 Timothy 1:9; Titus 1:2). Jesus came to enact that plan (John 4:34).

Part of that great plan was the establishment of the kingdom, or church. Jesus said in Matthew 16:18, "*Thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.*" In order to accomplish this Jesus had to shed His blood and give His life. Arising victorious over death He accomplished that which He had prophesied. In doing so He purchased the church with His blood (Acts 20:28).

The Hebrew writer tells us, "Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by His own blood He entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us" (Hebrews 9:12). Also notice, "Wherefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered without the gate" (Hebrews 13:12). Unto Him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in His own blood" (Revelation 1:5).

Now with these things in mind let me ask what I believe to be a most pertinent question, "What do we owe Him?" Some would say nothing at all and most live that way, but the truth is we owe Him everything! That is why we are told time and again to live faithful lives. He demands fidelity from each of us individually and every local congregation.

God's Word refers to the church of His dear Son as a bride. Sadly, so many, too many, are committing spiritual adultery. Individually, many who once were joined to the Son through the act of baptism have left Him for another. Be it the world or a denomination (which are not part of His church).


SUNDAY EVENING WORSHIP 1:15 P.M.
