I once had a screensaver on my computer that would cycle through various scenes whenever it is inactive for more than five minutes. The next time I move the computer mouse it would simply disappear. One day, while sitting at my desk working on the computer, I had several applications open at the same time when the phone rang and, as I was talking, I noticed that the screensaver tried to activate but couldn't and I received an error message across the bottom of the screen. The message said something to the effect of "The front application will not yield control."

I moved the computer mouse and found that the "front application" was my Bible program. The Bible program would not yield control to the screensaver. I thought there was some significance in this for you and me. If we allow the Bible to be the front application in our lives, that is, if we allow ourselves to be guided by the word of God, then it will not allow control to be yielded to the things of this world.

As God's children we are to walk even as he walked (1 John 2:6). 1 Peter 2:21 says, "For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps." Christ left us the Word so that we might know how to walk. Doesn't it then make good sense to yield control of our lives to God's Word? Notice what Paul said, "Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God...Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?...I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness" (Romans 6:13, 16, 19).

How does this happen? How do I make application?

"Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom" (Colossians 3:16).

"Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (2 Timothy 2:15).

"Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me" (John 5:39), and be as the Bereans who "received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so" (Acts 17:11).

Couple this with habitual prayer before the throne of the God, and with the knowledge of His love for mankind, and you will find yourself yielding only to the front application in your life, God (Matthew 6:33). Remember to thank God for loving you and don't forget that the church loves you too. Be faithful!
