"Black Friday," as it is now used to describe the day after Thanksgiving each year, originated with the Philadelphia Police Department as early as 1966. On this day the Christmas shopping season would begin in Center City, or downtown Philadelphia, and the Central Business district, as massive traffic jams and over-crowded sidewalks would bring chaos to the downtown stores. The designation of "Black Friday" began to be used more popularly outside of Philadelphia around 1975. Later it took on a broader and newer definition indicating the time when retailer's books would move from the "red" (loss) to the "black" (profit).

Today we know that "Black Friday" is a time of great sacrifice and chaos. Businesses offer unbelievable deals to move product and turn a profit while consumers seek out the best deals in the early morning darkness. For some of us "Black Friday" seems like a ridiculous exercise in madness. I personally don't need a deal that badly. However, there was a deal I needed on the very first "Black Friday!" The day in which Jesus of Nazareth died on the cross paying the price for my sin.

On the Thursday of the week of the Lord's death, Christ eats the Passover Feast with His disciples and is arrested in the Garden of Gethsemane at about midnight. He spends the better part of the early morning hours appearing before Annas and Caiaphas before being taken in front of the Sanhedrin Council, Herod and Pilate between 6AM and 9AM. At about 9 o'clock in the morning Jesus is crucified. Then in Matthew 27:45 we read that, "...from the sixth hour (noon) until the ninth hour (3:00PM) there was darkness over all the land."

At the end of this "Black Friday" Jesus had paid the price for my sins and for the sins of the entire world! A gift was purchased for me on that day, but it wasn't on sale, it cost God everything! But that gift wasn't just for me...it was for you too. The Apostle Paul wrote to Timothy and said, "Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing" (2 Timothy 4:8). Those who will love His appearing will be those who have accepted the gift and used it faithfully!
