Jesus came into this world to do one thing. Luke 19:10 says, "For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost." From the beginning of time the Father had a plan that would save mankind from death and offer redemption to all who would submit themselves to His Son (2 Timothy 1:9; Titus 1:2). Jesus came to enact that plan (John 4:34).

Part of that great plan was the establishment of the kingdom. Jesus said in Matthew 16:18, "You Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." In order to accomplish this Jesus had to shed His blood and give His life. Arising victorious over death He accomplished what He had prophesied. In doing so He purchased the church with His blood (Acts 20:28).

The Hebrew writer tells us, "Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us" (9:12). Also, "Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate" (13:12). And John wrote, "And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto Him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in His own blood" (Revelation 1:5).

Now, with these things in mind, let me ask what I believe to be a most pertinent question, "What do we own Him?" Some would say nothing at all and most live that way, but the truth is we owe Him everything! That is why we are told time and again to live faithful lives. He demands fidelity from each of us individually and from every local congregation.

God's Word refers to the church of His dear Son as a bride (Revelation 21:9). Sadly, so many, too many, are committing spiritual adultery. Individually, many who once were joined to the Son through the act of baptism have left Him for another. Be it the world or a denomination (which are not part of His church).

Many congregations have likewise run off with another man's wife. Some of them, like the physical adulterer, don't realize what they are doing. Others, unfortunately, know and just don't care. Innovations that have no biblical authority drive men into Satan's arms. Even those who do not hold to or teach some new or false thing can be guilty of spiritual unfaithfulness if they fail to do those things which are commanded.

I wonder how God feels when those He loves and gave His life for, who promised to love Him and be faithful, leave Him for another. If another has ever betrayed you, then you know how He feels. Why would we do that to Him who loves us so much?
