#### THE IMPORTANCE OF FOCUS FOR BEING BETTER

# I have often thought that I learned as much about life through wrestling in high school and college, coaching, and officiating than nearly everything else I experienced growing up. Winning and losing, training and preparation, friendship and hard work were all part of this education. Maybe the one thing that has stayed with me as much or more than anything else was the lessons I learned about focus. Goals needed to be focused, preparation needed to be focused, training needed to be focused, in the heat of battle there had to be focus. I lost the most important match of my high school career because of a momentary lack of focus.

Spiritually, I have seen and realized the importance of focus as well. The Bible speaks of it often in a variety of ways. Peter lost focus while walking to Jesus on the stormy waves of the Galilean Sea (Matthew 14:28–33). We too need to fix our eyes on Jesus, "the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God" (Hebrews 12:2).

The apostle Paul reminds us that, "If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God" (Colossians 3:1 –3).
