I remember years ago becoming separated from my mother at Hills Department Store in Springfield, Ohio. I couldn't have been more than 5 or 6 years old and I was terrified. Someone found me and took me to the Service Counter where my mother was paged. I also recall leaving the beach once while on a family vacation without telling my father. He was furious and panicked when I came back. Years later I understood just how my parents must have felt when my son David was lost in a Mall department store after wondering off. I was terrified and happened to spot him before he noticed me and recognized the frightened, anxious look in his face as he searched for us. I also remember hearing about the time my grandparents drove off from a gas station without my Uncle Steve. My mother and Uncle Tom sat silently in the back seat seemingly unconcerned that their little brother had been left behind.

Then it happened again. I guess it was bound to; somehow, somewhere. I don't believe we ever plan to lose or intend to abandon a child, but it happens. And it did! One evening Colleen took David and dropped him off at football practice. Practice was from 7:00-8:30 and I was helping some friends move some furniture. Colleen came to their house after dropping David off so she could go run an errand with her friend. When they returned we ended up sitting around their kitchen table visiting and I realized it was getting darker outside and we should probably be going when I looked at my watch and it was 9:00! Somewhat panicked, Colleen ran to her car and while dialing numbers on her cell she sped off to rescue poor David.

When we all arrived back home, and everything (and everyone) was fine, I was impressed with how well David took our little oversight. He told his mother at one point, "Mom, you're too nice...you've already said you were sorry like a hundred times." He wasn't the same little boy who just a few years earlier was scared and lost in a department store.

All this made me think that as children of God we are never forgotten and we are never left behind. The psalmist David wrote, "Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? If I ascend into heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there" (Psalm 139:7-8). What a comfort it is to the godly that He is always there with us.

Peter wrote, "For the eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, And His ears are open to their prayers..." (1 Peter 3:12). And the Hebrew writer encouraged us to, "Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." (Hebrews 13:5). Be faithful...and you will never be alone!
