#### **Are You Intelligent?**

They allege that the Bible, God's plan to save man, the acts of worship, and the one true church Jesus died for just doesn't make any sense to them. Then I must ask, "What are they really saying?"

We are told that mankind was created in the very image of God (Genesis 1:27). Who among us would deny that God is an intelligent Creator and Being (Romans 8:27; Hebrews 4:13)?
