She is like the merchant ships, she brings her food from afar.

 - B. God's servant does not continue in sin (1 John 2:29; 3:7)
- IV. WE ARE DELIVERED TO SERVE GOD WITHOUT _____ (Heb 10:23)
 - A. God is faithful!
 - B. So, Jesus encourages us to endure until then end (Matt 24:13, 42)
