My Aunt Carol passed away ten years ago and while I have a number of memories of her, it is one of the final acts of her life that has stuck with me most. I had seen her the week before her death and prayed with her family and all were comforted by the fact that she was an obedient, faithful Christian. But it was her preparation for death that had the greatest impact on many of her family and friends. When she was diagnosed with an inoperable brain tumor just three months earlier she began her preparation. The funeral service, what she would wear, who the pallbearers would be, the family dinner, who would prepare the food; she planned everything just the way she wanted it. She even made a list for Uncle Russell so he would know what to buy for their grandchildren for Christmas next year. She even planned for her husband to marry her best friend, Meredith, and a few years later I officiated a private marriage ceremony for them on the back deck of our home.

The greatest preparation she made though was how she had prepared herself spiritually; beginning with her baptism many years ago and followed by many years of faithful service to God, the church, her family, neighbors, and friends. In Hebrews 9:27 we read, "...it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment." We are all destined to an eternal, spiritual life after physical death. The question is, "Are we prepared?"

In Amos 4:12 the prophet says Israel had not repented of their evil deeds and returned to God in faithfulness. He warns, "Therefore... O Israel: ... prepare to meet thy God." The Bible is filled with warnings concerning our need for preparation. In Matthew 25 the five foolish virgins not only failed to remain alert and watchful but they were also unprepared. We are told that those who were ready were allowed to enter in (verse 10). In chapter 24 Jesus said, "Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh" (verse 44).

In Acts 21 Paul and his companions come to Caesarea and stayed with Philip the evangelist. A prophet, named Agabus, came to see them and took Paul's belt, bound his own hands and feet, and said, "... the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owns this belt, and shall deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles." When his companions heard these things they begged him not to go up to Jerusalem. Paul answered, "What mean ye to weep and to break mine heart? For I am ready not to be bound only, but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus" (verses 8-13). Paul was prepared! In fact, just prior to his death he wrote to Timothy and said, "For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand" (2 Timothy 4:6).

No wise man ever goes on a journey without preparing for it first. Jesus went on before us to prepare a place for us in eternity (John 14:2-3). Are we prepared? Heaven is a prepared place for a prepared people. Hell is a prepared place for an unprepared people. Prepare to meet thy God. Understand the will of God (Ephesians 5:17), repent of your sins and turn to Christ (Acts 17:30-31), confess the sweet name of Jesus with your words and with your life (Matthew 10:32-33), be buried with him in baptism to wash away your sins and be transported out of darkness and into the body of Christ (Acts 2:38; Galatians 3:27; Colossians 1:13. Serve Him and be prepared.
