My life started at the moment of my conception but will end before I ever see the light of the world.

I will never know the happiness of a sixteenth birthday. I will never know the joy of worship. I will never know the delight of music. I will never know the elation of myself begin a parent or to be able to bless generations of progeny to come with my love and my life.

I will never be able to give the world the cure for cancer that lies dormant in my mind just waiting to be discovered and shared. I will never be able to preach the gospel to the world and help countless souls come to Jesus in order to be saved. I will never be elected to public office and bring peace to a warring world. I will never be allowed to realize my fullest, God-given potential that is sure to bring the greatest happiness for the greatest number of people.


