I have always been interested in history and especially my family history. My project the only year I was in 4-H as a boy was on genealogy. I have always wanted to trace my family's history and years ago I started in the one place in which I was most interested. I took a few days off and headed to Eastern Kentucky to research my father's side of the

I found what I expected to find...not much. My grandfather moved to Ohio in 1957 and in 1967 and 1969 sold the entire family farm that he had acquired from my greatgrandfather. Since then the farm had grown over, someone had built a cabin (the old ones are long gone). The family burial plots on the farm had long since been lost. The descriptions on the deeds to the property were not much help either. Descriptions including rocks, houses (that no longer exist), the lost family cemeteries, a hickory tree, and a garden that hasn't been tilled or planted for many years. There were a few folks left that remembered the Dooley name and only two discernible grave sites were located; my great-grandfather and grandmother and one of his sons and his wife.

Beyond my great-grandfather's grave there were no memorials found to the previous three generations that died in Lawrence County. I did find the obituary of my great great-grandfather, marriage licenses, and death certificates in addition to the land deeds. All of this reminded me that time passes swiftly and we are soon forgotten. The Psalmist said he was "*forgotten as a dead man out of mind*" (Psalm 31:12). As many of our ancestors are unknown to all future generations so some future generation may soon have no memory or memorial of me. I hope though that I can leave a spiritual legacy for years to come.

The only thing that really matters in life is if we live in such a way as to hear the Father say, "Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord" (Matthew 25:21). "For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul" (Matthew 16:26).

I'm also reminded that Christ is coming again and all that are in the grave will hear His voice and will come forth from their resting places; some to the resurrection of life and others to the resurrection of damnation (John 5:28-29). While many lay in unmarked and forgotten graves God won't need a marker when He comes to take us home.

I am thankful for the family I have. For the ancestors who loved me enough to teach me the truth and lived lives that exemplified Christ. I am also thankful for a wide-reaching spiritual family. For their love, support, friendship, and encouragement. I am thankful for my New Albany family.

I have continued my search to learn as much as I can about my family heritage. But my prayer is that the heritage I leave for my family will be one of love, obedience, and faithfulness to the Father of our souls. "*Thy name, O LORD, endureth for ever; and thy memorial, O LORD, throughout all generations*" (Psalm 135:13).
