We dare not underestimate the importance of being together on a regular basis. God knew the importance of it and determined that we should gather together every first day of the week. Instead of looking at what happens when we are gathered together, let us consider the effects of not gathering together.

I was very involved in my high school. I was class president. I played basketball. I spent a lot of time with my friends. There are a number of individuals with whom I spent a great deal of time. One of them even shared my last name. We often talked about how great it would be if we were brothers. But those days occurred in Florida.

Upon graduation, I headed off to Freed-Hardeman College. The Summer after my Freshman year was the last time I ever lived at home. The Summer after graduation Rebecca and I were married, and my parents moved to Alabama.

Those people with whom I had spent my entire pre-college school career faded into the memories of the past. Over the years, I have attended two reunions. They were always enjoyable and we reminisced about the past. But, things were different than they used to be. It's not that I did not want to be around them anymore. It's just that I did not know them anymore. Once we were very close, but time and distance replaced those friends with other friends.

I can apply this to my family (and you can to yours). We just returned from a family gathering, a yearly reunion of sorts. We do this every year. We have our three children, their spouses, and our 7 grandchildren in the same place together for an extended period of time.

Families raise their children and then send them out to live their lives. They try to get together as often as possible to stay as close as possible. However, those children grow with and into their families. The family reunions allow them to reconnect and learn about each other since last they were together. Sure, they have talked and visited through phone calls, emails, and even video calls, but nothing can replace that face-to-face presence.

God's family was made as a together group. We have been "fitted together" (Ephesians 2:21). This is a compound word linking together "joined closely with", "a joint", and "reason". The meaning is that God's family has been put together reasonably with all that it needs to be a together group. Being together in person allows each one to draw from every other one while contributing to the group what he or she has to offer individually. We have been "built together" (Ephesians 2:22).

Both of these words show the intentionality of God in His provisions for His family. He also gave His intentionality for His family when He commanded that they be together on a regular basis (*Hebrews 10:25*). While the weekly assembly of worship is the focus of this verse, there is an underlying message. Togetherness is not just about the Sunday assemblies. To stay connected and as close as possible to each other, we need to take advantage of as many opportunities as possible to be together.

I don't believe that those who minimize their opportunities to be together intend to give up their church family. I believe they just grow distant because of one missing ingredient—being together. We dare not underestimate its importance!
