

Mr. Harold will surely be missed by all who knew and loved him. But we take great comfort in knowing the kind of Christian man he was. We are comforted to know that he no longer knows pain, suffering, or sorrow and that he rests from his labors (Revelation 14:13; Psalm 116:15). We also take great joy in knowing that one day we can be reunited with him again. If Jesus returns before we die, Harold will be with Him when He does return. If we pass before that day, we know he will be waiting for us on the other side. Either way, what a glorious day it will be.


