There's Only One Tim Dooley

In Ephesians four Paul is addressing a real problem existing in the church. The problem was division among the brethren. As in his letter to the Corinthians he wanted them to be united. He encouraged them to endeavor "to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" (v. 3). We do this, he says, by walking worthy of the calling with which we were called "with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love" (vs. 1-2).

Sure, they all had different individual callings, but they were to be used together for the edification of the whole church, not just for individual glory. The goal was unity, maturity, and faithfulness. The church was meant to be a group of individuals "called out" of the world to supply love, strength, and encouragement to one another (vs. 11-16).

However, in verses 4-6, he speaks of some things in which we have no freedom of our own personal ideas, interpretations, or indulgence. Some contend these things of which Paul speaks are so unique in nature that there cannot be another (real or imagined); while others teach that these things are open to individual interpretation. But what exactly is the apostle Paul saying here? He says there is:

One Body – There is only one body that belongs to Christ and to which true Christians are added. Since the church of Christ and the body are the same thing (Ephesians 1:22-23; 5:23; Colossians 1:18) and since there are many different denominations that claim Christ as their head what is Paul talking about? The one "true" body belongs to Christ (Colossians 2:17) and every other, while it may claim to be His, is not the one "true" bodv.

One Spirit – While the Bible speaks of many different "spirits" there is only one true Spirit from above that is able to teach and guide us to heaven.

One Hope – People place their hopes and dreams on many things the true Christian recognizes as hopeless dreams. There are many hopes that men have but only one that will result in what we really want and need (Romans 8:24).

One Lord – People serve many different lords. People call on lords to save them. The world is filled with idolatry, service, and worship to lords that cannot save. He means here that there is one "true" Lord in whom we have hope. Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me" (John 14:6).

One Faith – How many faiths are there? The dictionary defines faith as "complete trust or confidence in someone or something." The Greek word means to have a "persuasion" or "conviction." The Muslim has a faith; as do the Buddhist, Jews, Hindus, Spiritualists, humanists, Atheists, Deists, and Pantheist. So, what does Paul mean here? There is only one "true, saving" faith (Romans 1:5)!

One Baptism – There have been and are many baptisms. The Bible speaks of no less than seven. Yet by the time of Paul's epistle to the church at Ephesus there was only one valid baptism and it was the one that would save them (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38-40; Acts 19:1-5; 1 Peter 3:21).

One God and Father of All – Here is the culminating statement. The Christian needed to remember that their heavenly Father was the one true and living God (1 Thessalonians 1:9). He was above all, through all and in them all. So, they needed to be united on these truths and work together for edification and eternal life.

Aren't you glad there are no divisions among us today? Oh yeah, right! Why are there divisions among us? Because people are following or are a part of many different bodies, spirits, hopes, lords, faiths, baptisms, and gods. Let's take a moment for honest reflection and ask ourselves who are we serving, what do we believe, is it helping to unify, am I contributing to the edification of the saints? Am I on the right path to heaven?
