Glorifying God in His Home

Within 40 years of the death of Ezekiel (@570 BC) the ground surrounding the ruins of the first temple began to be cleared and construction of the second temple began. The temple was completed and consecrated in the spring of 516 BC. It is imperative to keep in mind that the purpose of the repopulation of Judea and the rebuilding of the temple was to glorify the name of God, not only among the children of Israel but also in the sight of all the heathen nations.

Is it any wonder then that the Lord was so angered at the corruption of the priesthood and the merchandise which was being made in the temple during His time (John 2:13–17)? Glorifying God in His purposes leads mankind to righteousness and blessings from above. Exalting self, and thereby failing to give God the glory, results in sin and the righteous indignation of the Lord.

Defiling His temple, the church, today will likewise invite the ire of God. How are we bringing glory to the name of the Lord within the walls of his house today? Consider these suggestions.

- 1. Worship Him in spirit and in truth (John 4:23–24). One should prepare himself to worship and be determined to assemble with the saints on every occasion (Hebrews 10:25). But one must also actively praise and venerate God once assembled. It saddens me to see Christians standing during the invitation song and not singing, folks not following along with the study of Scripture, and not meditating on the death of the Lord during the Lord's Supper. One cannot worship in spirit and in truth while not being actively engaged in praising the Lord.
- 2. Serve Him (Matthew 23:11). Serving God in the church by serving others takes humility and effort. The opposite of this is the exaltation of self mentioned earlier, incurring the wrath of God.
- 3. Love each other (1 Peter 1:22). The second greatest command was "love thy neighbor" (Matthew 22:39). By this shall all men know that we are His disciples (John 13:35).
- 4. Bring others to Christ (John 4:35). The greatest way to glorify God in the church is to help bring others to the Cross. We do this first by being a light unto the world (Matthew 5:14–16), but we also do it with our mouths (Matthew 28:19; Acts 8:4).


