Something Guaranteed

We like to think that whatever we buy is backed by a guarantee. In fact, we wouldn't invest what we do in automobiles without being assured that there was a warranty. We cannot afford to take the chance. But what about things that have to do with the soul? Can we afford to take a chance on something that has no guarantee when it concerns the soul? Surely not, for the soul is worth more than an automobile.

But can we find things guaranteed in religion? Can I be sure of these things? I believe so. I base this on a statement made by Paul, "But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man" (Gal. 1:11). Among other things, he is saying you have the word of an [apostle]. Later in the chapter, he will say, "Now the things which I write unto you, behold, before God, I lie not" (Gal. 1:20).

THAT ONE MUST BELIEVE IN CHRIST IS GUARANTEED. We have no doubt about this being backed up by apostolic certification. Read Romans 10:9-10.

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved . . .

One thus has the word of an apostle that he is to believe.

THAT ONE MUST REPENT IS GUARANTEED. We [need] only [to] look at Acts 2:38 or Acts 17:30 to hear the apostles telling men to repent. That we must repent is guaranteed by the word of the apostles.

THAT ONE MUST CONFESS IS GUARANTEED. Return to Romans 10:9-10, and there we are told by the inspired apostle, "If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus" and later he says, "For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." The word of Paul guarantees that this must be done.

THAT ONE MUST BE BAPTIZED IS GUARANTEED. The first mention of baptism by the apostles after receiving the great commission is found in Acts 2:38. But what they had to say was by inspiration. Thus, it has Heaven's sanction. Here they are told to "be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins."

I can't have any doubt but that these things are guaranteed because of what the apostles said about them. That is as much guarantee as we need.


