John 3:16 Means What It Says Tim Dooley

From our childhood we have known this beautiful verse; first spoken by the Son of God Himself and later penned for our learning and edification. The sad thing is that for many years the denominational world has twisted and corrupted this beautiful scripture to propagate a false doctrine and extend to countless souls a false hope. So just what does this verse actually say?

First, it says "The God," the one and only Creator of all things, and who has in His hands the salvation and condemnation of His creation, "so loved the 'kosmos." Thayer says that this word in its context means "*the inhabitants of the earth, men, the human race*." Since mankind, in its totality, had sinned and separated himself from God and life (Isaiah 59:1-2; Romans 3:10, 23; 5:12), God in His infinite love, chose to do something to redeem man and offer us a second chance.

What was that? He "gave his only begotten Son." The Second Person of the Godhead agreed to take on the role of Son and Savior; be "made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death" and "taste death for every man" (Hebrews 2:9). God the Father, therefore, sent His Son to die for our sins, the only sacrifice worthy for our propitiation and sanctification. Now if the verse ended there then just maybe the "faith only" crowd or non-religious, who want to live any old life they choose claiming God's Son as a universal, unconditional sacrifice, may just have a weak, atrophied leg to stand on.

However, Jesus spoke on, "that whosoever believes in him should not perish." Three important things for us to notice here. 1) There is a burden placed upon all men who have ever lived since the death of Jesus. The word 'believes' here means to "place your faith or trust in." It is more than just a mental affirmation that Jesus is the Son of God. It means we must listen, obey, and be faithful to His teachings. 2) The English phrase "should not" is rendered from the single Greek word which means this is the ONLY way to keep from eternal damnation. This word should NOT be translated or understood as an absolute such as "shall not." 3) The word "perish" indicates a foundational biblical principle. As long as we are joined to God in a spiritual relationship we have spiritual life. But since sin separates us from God, and brings forth spiritual death, if we die physically separated from Him, we have eternal death (separation). Our only hope is Christ.

So, the logical question would be the same as asked on the day of Pentecost (Acts 2:28), by Saul of Tarsus (Acts 9:6), and the Philippian Jailor (Acts 16:30), "What must we do to be saved?" Obviously, God's love shown to us demands reciprocal love from us. Jesus said, "If you love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15). And, "And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?" (Luke 6:46).

So... Repent of your sins (Acts 17:30), Confess Jesus (Luke 9:26), and do what all those men on Pentecost, Saul of Tarsus, and the Jailor did. "Then they that gladly received his word were baptized..." (Acts 2:41). But then remember, this is only the beginning! One must "...observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you" (Matthew 28:20), and "be faithful unto death" (Revelation 2:10).
