Church Calendar

"So thou shalt put the evil away from among you" (Deuteronomy 17:7). Tim Dooley

On several occasions in the book of Deuteronomy the Children of Israel are reminded to remove sin from the camp so that the camp might be made pure once again from the defilement of sin. A simple request, but not so simple in application. Time and time again the children of Israel allowed sin to go unchecked in the camp and the result was always disastrous (Joshua 7). But God is faithful and forgiving, so, whenever the sin was dealt with (this meant removal, repentance, and the righteous suffering of consequences), God blessed them.

Much of our conflict today (be it in the home, society, or even the church) is a direct result of not following this Old Testament example and the subsequent New Testament commands to do the same. When writing to the church at Corinth concerning the immorality that was being allowed to continue in the congregation Paul commanded, "Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person" (1 Corinthians 5:13). When writing to Titus he commanded by inspiration that the church was to, "Reject a divisive man after the first and second admonition" (Titus 3:10).

In order for the home to be truly blessed it must be cleansed of sin. This means adulterous marriages must be severed (Matthew 19:9; Hebrews 13:4), homosexual relationships must be repented of (1 Corinthians 6:9–10), and all forms of worldliness and immorality must be eradicated from our homes (Titus 2:12).

In order for our society to become godly and reap the blessings of the Father we need to turn from our immoral ways (Jeremiah 18:8), cleanse ourselves as a people, stand for the truth (1 Corinthians 16:13), and bring into office leaders who will stand for biblical principles. We need to be praying for this every day (1 Timothy 2:1–2)!

In order to remain pure and holy as the people of God, the church of Jesus Christ, the unrepentant sinner must be removed from our fellowship and we cannot let our personal feelings stand between us and God in doing His will (Matthew 10:37). We need to remember that, "A little leaven leavens the whole lump" (1 Corinthians 5:6; Galatians 5:9). And we as Christians need to strive to keep ourselves pure, without spot or blemish (2 Peter 3:14). The ultimate responsibility for keeping the church pure lies individually with each one of us. If you are not a baptized Christian, obey him by believing (John 6:29), repenting (Acts 26:20), confessing (Matthew 10:32–33), and being baptized for the remission of your sins (Acts 2:38). And if you are a Christian...Be faithful!

The children's reaction was incredible, as they obviously cherished the quilts as a prized possession.


