



In the book of Nehemiah, we learn that in a mere 52 days, the walls of Jerusalem are rebuilt after years of neglect following the destruction of the city. A herculean task to be sure. But consider how this proves the power of God working through His faithful children. In Nehemiah 4:6 we read, "So built we the wall; and all the wall was joined together unto the half thereof: for the people had a mind to work." Not only did they have a mind to work but they were determined to defend the walls of the city while they worked. Nehemiah 4:18 says, "Every one of the builders had his sword girded at his side as he built. And the one who sounded the trumpet was beside me."

Upon completion of the walls we are told that Ezra brought the book of the Law of Moses and "*read from it in the open square that was in front of the Water Gate from morning until midday, before the men and women and those who could understand; and the ears of all the people were attentive to the Book of the Law" (8:3). Verse six tells us that "all the people answered, 'Amen, Amen!' while lifting up their hands. And they bowed their heads and worshiped the LORD with their faces to the ground." All this because they read distinctly from the book, in the Law of God; and they gave the sense, and helped <i>them* to understand the reading" (verse 7). Thus the people repented, the people and the temple were cleansed, and the walls are dedicated.

We too can do great things with God. However, we need to be mindful that no matter how great a work seems to be, if God is not involved, it will all be for naught! The Psalmist warned that, "*Except the LORD build the house, they labor in vain that build it: except the LORD keep the city, the watchman stays awake in vain*" (Psalm 127:1). We must have a heart ready to hear, repent, obey, work, and fight to defend our house and the house of the Lord.

Are you on the Lord's side? Obey Him and be faithful!
