A Letter from Casey

Note: I ran this article in May of 2022. But with today's second service sermon and our emphasis on standing up for the lives of unborn children, I wish for you to take a moment and read it again. Consider the message with an open and honest heart. – Tim

My name is Casey and I am one-month old. That is, I was conceived one month ago today. However, my family and friends will never know me. The world will never realize the wonderful things I would accomplish or how I would bless all mankind with my achievements in science, philosophy, and international relations.

Although I am made in the very image of God (Psalm 139:13; Genesis 1:27) I will not be allowed the opportunity to love Him, serve Him, and cause others to glorify Him by my life (Matthew 5:13-16). Some claim I am not a human being: even though from the moment of my conception I bear every genetic marker that makes me a human and have human parents with whom I will never be able to share my love. My life started at the moment of my conception but will end before I ever see the light of the world.

I will never know the happiness of a sixteenth birthday. I will never know the joy of worship. I will never know the delight of music. I will never know the elation of myself being a parent or being able to bless generations of progeny to come with my love and my life.

I will never be able to give the world the cure for cancer that lies dormant in my mind just waiting to be discovered and shared. I will never be able to preach the gospel to the world and help countless souls come to Jesus in order to be saved. I will never be elected to public office and bring peace to a warring world. I will never be allowed to realize my fullest, God-given, potential that is sure to bring the greatest happiness for the greatest number of people.

My father will mourn the fact that he will never get to hold me in his arms, teach me to ride a bike, see me graduate from college, walk me down the aisle, or give me the sweetest grandchild. My mother will suffer with both physical and emotional scars for the rest of her life. My grandparents will struggle for years financially, emotionally, and spiritually while trying to help my parents deal with their pain.

Any moment now my life will end in a nondescript, upper-middle-class, abortion clinic at the hands of a doctor supported by government tax dollars. My mother has decided that her current happiness at not being pregnant or "burdened" with the responsibility of raising a child is more important than the ultimate happiness she, and so many others, would know if she were to love, care for, and deliver me to this world. There is a couple who want to be my parents, and who want me to be their child and would be overjoyed to raise me, but my mom only cares about not living with this "embarrassment" inside of her. No, any moment now my young life will end, but the negative effects of my ultimate demise will echo in eternity.
