"Purity" Tim Dooley

In Leviticus 21–22 we find God's instructions concerning the priests of Israel. We read of the spotlessness of the animals that would serve as sacrifices. Reading the book of Leviticus reminds us of the importance God placed on the purity of His priesthood and the children of Israel. The history of Israel's people is also a reminder of the consequences of impurity (Ezekiel 36:16–21). God is righteous and just, and He does not overlook or tolerate impurity.

All Christians today live as both the children of God and as His priests here on earth (1 Peter 2:5–9); but, unlike the Levitical priesthood's requirements to be without blemish in the flesh, God wants the Christian priesthood to be pure in heart and mind. "*But* as *He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, 'Be holy, for I am holy"* (1 Peter 1:15–16).

On a personal level, the apostle Paul commands Timothy to not allow anyone to "despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity" (1 Timothy 4:12). The imperative here is a profound warning because, "no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God" (Ephesians 5:5).

Isaiah 1:18 invites all to "*Come now, and let us reason together*," says the Lord, "*Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, they shall be as wool.*" Jesus can cleanse us, purify us, and save us through our obedience (1 Peter 1:22). But we must also be striving daily to draw near to God, cleanse our hands, and purify our hearts (James 4:8). That is faithfulness...Be pure and be faithful!
