My Lord said, "No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon" (Matthew 6:24).

You can "talk the talk," but "can you walk the walk" one may ask. Lots of people claim to be Christians but more often is the case that folks are practicing counterfeit Christianity.


Again, calling on the words of Jesus, we learn that "Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?" (Matthew 7:22). A testimony to the fact that the religious are often more talk than action, Jesus says that some people call on my name but their actions don't match their words.

So, what about you and me? Are we Christians or counterfeit Christians? Here's a test:

- Do you give every Lord's Day, but only what's leftover from the weekend before?
- Do you pray, but only when in need of something?
- Do you worship on Sunday, but only if it doesn't interfere with your work or play schedules?
- Do you profess love for God, but fail to show love for His people?
- Do you render good for evil, or is vengeance your goal?
- Do you sing "to the work, to the work" on Sunday, but on Monday never say a word for Jesus?
- Do you attend every Bible class, and worship service faithfully but have a rotten attitude during the week?
- Do you talk about what the church needs to be doing, but you never engage your own heart and life in her service?

If these points have crept into your life, then perhaps you're more of a counterfeit Christian than a New Testament Christian.

Why not make it a point this week to just be a Christian. It won't be easy, but living for Jesus makes life worth the living.


