
# Honoring Faithful Generations Tim Dooley



The Apostle Paul tells Timothy that when he brings himself to remember Timothy's sincere faith, he his reminded that it "dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice," and he was confident that the same faith also lived on in Timothy (1 Timothy 1:5). What a beautiful and encouraging thing for us to consider. Three generations of faith! Faith that was passed on from generation to generation.

The old saying goes that the church is but one generation away from apostasy. That is not hyperbole! I've seen it in my lifetime: one generation is faithful, their offspring are taught and obey but are not rooted, their faith choked out by the cares and riches of the world, and they fall away. Their children then are reared without faith at all in the Lord, they have no knowledge of the one true and living God, they have no fellowship with the Lord and His church, they live worldly, ungodly lives.

To see multiple generations of faithfulness in Christ today should bring up the same fondness within us that it did for Paul when recalling the faith of Timothy, his mother, and grandmother. It is also a profound lesson on our responsibility to bring our children up in the "nurture and admonition of the Lord" (Ephesians 6:4). We can continue to follow a succession of obedient and faithful generations, or we can begin a new tradition of generational Christianity. The only hope I and my loved ones may have of inheriting eternal life may well be if they see first my faith. Be faithful my friends.
