A Lively Hope

In 1 Peter 1:2-5 the Apostle writes to the “elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace be multiplied. Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.” WOW!

He said God the Father has “Begotten us again.” This phrase comes from the Greek word “to cause to be born again.” We who are in Christ have been born again, made new, alive from the dead! This new life is a life of “living hope” that we have “through the resurrection of Jesus” following His death on the cross and our obedience to the gospel of salvation (Romans 6:1-11)

The eternal result of this new life of hope is an inheritance that is...

1. **Death-proof:** Incorruptible here means immortal or imperishable. The inheritance will never cease to be. It is eternal, everlasting, unending!
2. **Dirt-proof:** Undefiled! The inheritance has never been, nor will it ever be soiled, deformed, or debased. Its force and potency are never impaired. Its power never diminished.
3. **Decay-proof:** It never fades away. Its beauty is perennial! Not nicks, dents, tarnish, rust, or deterioration.

He tells us this inheritance is “reserved in heaven” for all who have arisen to live in hope of it. That is for those who have been obedient to the gospel of Christ. Having repented of their sins, confessed Jesus, and been buried with Him in baptism. Do you have this hope? Are you faithfully living with the earnest anticipation of the inheritance reserved in heaven for you? Obey Him today and be faithful. Heaven will surely be worth it all!
