Fathers, Are You Fulfilling Your Duty?

Over many years I have witnessed countless young souls who were carried faithfully to Sunday School and worship by their mothers. Mothers who desperately sought for their children to be filled with the knowledge of Jesus and His love and who would grow up to be obedient, faithful, children of God. They wrangled them into and out of the car, struggled with them during worship, and prayed for them every night. And despite their best efforts, many of them, grieve over their “failure.” The children grew up, left home, and followed not in the paths of their mothers, but in the wayward path of their fathers who were all the while home sitting in their recliner, off playing golf, or out of town on another more important business trip.

Ephesians 6:4 states, “*And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.*” Dad, your children, especially your sons, will most likely grow up in your shadow and mimic your behavior. Your daughters will seek out a companion who has many of the characteristics of her dad. If my son grows up to be just like me, what kind of man will he be? If my daughter marries a man like her father, will he be the kind of man who will help my little girl go to heaven when her life on earth comes to an end?

The wise author of Proverbs says, “*Hear, my children, the instruction of a father, and give attention to know understanding: for I give you good doctrine: do not forsake my law. When I was my father's son, tender and the only one in the sight of my mother, he also taught me and said to me: 'Let your heart retain my words; keep my commands and live. Get wisdom! Get understanding!'*” (Proverbs 4:1-5).

Certainly, all parents have God-given responsibilities toward their children; but they begin with the dad, the leader of the home and family. It is high time that we dads step up, take our responsibilities seriously, love our children, our wives, and our own lives enough to submit to the Lord and lead an obedient and faithful life.

“But” someone argues, “my son is going to play major league baseball someday!” First of all, probably not! The kid ran to third base last week on a weak grounder back to the pitcher! But what if he does? Out of all players who play minor league baseball only about 10% of those players who sign contracts each year will play at least 1 game in the majors. A boy playing little league baseball has a 0.0296% chance of playing professionally. Of all the boys who have played in the Little League World Series only 64 have made it to the majors. And of those who do make it to the majors the career lifespan of a player is only 5.6 years.

How long is eternity? Everyone makes it there! Will your child be prepared? Fathers, are you fulfilling your duty? It is time for us to step up and be the dads our children desperately need us to be.
