
None of us is ever right 100% of the time and some of us are wrong more often than we are right. We all sin and continue to fall short of God's glory, mercy, love, and forgiveness (Romans 3:23) At times we all need loving correction (Galatians 6:1). But nobody likes to be told they are wrong and our attitude toward sin and righteous living often dictates how we accept righteous rebuke.

King David asks for the righteous to smite him. He wrote, "Let the righteous smite me; *it shall be* a kindness: and let him reprove me; *it shall be* an excellent oil, *which* shall not break my head: for yet my prayer also *shall be* in their calamities" (Psalm 141:5). Notice he called it a kindness and said their reproof was an excellent oil.

The apostle Paul asked the Galatian brethren, "Am I therefore become your enemy, because I tell you the truth?" (Galatians 4:16). A true friend will tell us when we are wrong, and a righteous heart will receive the rebuke in love and do something to make it right.

Consider these verses: Proverbs 27:6, "Faithful *are* the wounds of a friend; but the kisses of an enemy *are* deceitful." Proverbs 25:12, "*Like* an earring of gold and an ornament of fine gold is a wise rebuker to an obedient ear." Ecclesiastes 7:5, "*It is* better to hear the rebuke of the wise, than for a man to hear the song of fools."

Thankfully God is always near when we call on Him in truth for forgiveness and support. Let brotherly love continue and be faithful to the God of all creation.
