. When the End Comes Will You Be Ready? Tim Dooley

Paul concludes his first letter to the church at Corinth in 1 Corinthians 15–16 by detailing the gospel message, as well as a treatise on the resurrection of the dead. He asserts that when Jesus returns, He will deliver the kingdom (the realm of God's rule over which He is King) up to God the Father. That kingdom includes the faithful subjects (citizens) known as Christians. In order for us to live with Christ for eternity it is imperative that we be part of that kingdom when that day comes. Being a part of that kingdom begins with our obedience to the death, burial and resurrection of Christ in baptism (Acts 2:28; Romans 6:1–6). But notice what else Paul declares needs to be done.

- 1. Associate yourself with the right people (15:33). Fellowship and association with the world will result in eternal life with them in destruction and death.
- Wake up to doing righteousness, not sin, and have knowledge of God (15:34). In order to walk in righteousness, we need to know and live in accordance with His Word.
- 3. Be determined and consistent in doing the Lord's work (15:58). Retirement from the Christian life will take place on that day. If we retire before then, we retire too soon.
- 4. Be alert, stand fast, act like men, and be strong (16:13). Being a Christian is not for the weak of heart and mind.
- 5. Let your life be dictated by love (16:14). God is love, and the world must see His love in our lives. If we love, we abide with Him here in this life and in eternity.

Do you see yourself faithfully living out these attributes in your life? If Jesus were to return today to deliver the kingdom up to the Father would you be ready? He is the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him (Hebrews 5:8–9). Fulfillment of that salvation is complete in faithful service (Matthew 25:21, 23). Obey Him and be faithful.
