Prove It -(2 Corinthians 8–10)! Tim Dooley

In 2 Corinthians 8 the primary concern revolves around the collection to be taken up for the poor. Paul speaks to the liberality of the saints in Macedonia (8:1–5) and how he had boasted of the love of the Corinthians (8:6–7; 9:1–5). He also speaks to Titus' qualifications and trustworthiness to take possession of the money and deliver it on their behalf.

Chapter nine continues this thought expressing the need for bountiful, purposeful, and cheerful giving that through us God's grace may abound toward us in everything they do. In this God's grace is made known to the world.

In chapter ten Paul's address changes so dramatically from the first nine chapters that many scholars believe that this is in fact a completely different letter. His condemnation is on those who questioned Paul's authority, appearance, and preaching style. These men sought to approve themselves and disprove Paul. He points out that we are involved in a spiritual warfare and that we are not physical opponents. The people of our world are not our enemies. Evil, ungodliness, worldliness, and unrighteousness are what we are to fight against.

The importance of all this is that we as Christians should do all that we do not "for" men, but "for" the Lord. In doing the Lord's will we are of the most benefit to God and men. We do not seek the approval of men but seek to "prove ourselves" faithful to the Lord with whom we live and one day will be judged. "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?" (2 Corinthians 13:5). "But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another" (Galatians 6:4). "Prove all things; hold fast that which is good" (1 Thessalonians 5:21). Don't just say it, prove it! And be faithful.
