The Cost of Service

Tim Dooley

In 2 Samuel 24:24 we read that King David refused to offer unto God a sacrifice that did not cost him something. A sacrifice that doesn't cost anything is really no sacrifice at all! In fact, inherent in the definition of sacrifice is the idea of expense. Yet so many in our world, and even in the church today, want to give God that which is no real sacrifice to them at all. We give God what is left over after we have satisfied our own needs and desires, our hand-me-downs, our undesirables, and we expect God in turn to bless us with new and better things.

The author C. S. Lewis once wrote concerning giving that "the only safe rule is to give more than we can spare. In other words, if our expenditure on comforts, luxuries, amusements, etc, is up to the standard common among those with the same income as our own, we are probably giving away too little. If our charities do not at all pinch or hamper us, I should say they are too small. There ought to be things we should like to do and cannot do because our charitable expenditure excludes them."

Without controversy we know that our lives are to be living sacrifices. "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God" (Romans 12:1–2 NKJV). That is each day from the first fruits, the best of our hearts, the greatest of our words, the finest of our thoughts, and the full force of our labors. Doing all to and for the Lord. "And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ" (Colossians 3:23–24).


