In the beginning of Luke's gospel account, we read of the story of the birth of Christ and the early days of His life. It is easy for us to overlook the wonder that his family experienced. John the baptizer's father, Zacharias, is struck speechless by the angel Gabriel because of his unbelief. 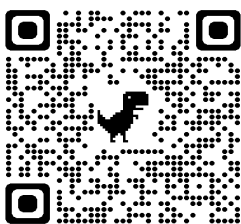
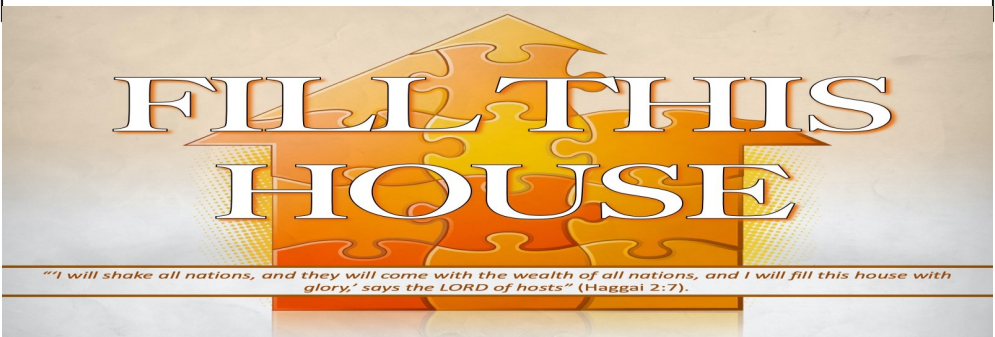

In Mark 1:27 we learn that, "they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, 'What is this? What new doctrine is this? For with authority He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him.'" In Mark 2:12, we are told "all were amazed and glorified God, saying, 'We never saw anything like this!'" And in Mark 5:42 the people were "overcome with great amazement."

Even more so, after the resurrection, the work grew and filled the earth with bewilderment and awe. In Acts 2:7, 12; 3:11; 8:13; and 9:21 we are told that time and time again the people marveled and were greatly amazed and the teaching and miracles that were being done.

The gospel of salvation was preached in every corner of the earth (Colossians 1:5-6), to Jews and Gentiles alike, and was being confirmed by signs, wonders, and miracles (Hebrews 2:3-4). We are even told in Acts 17:6 that the Christians had turned the world "upside down."

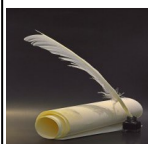
