Do These Things


In Zechariah's prophetic message of encouragement to the people of Israel in Zechariah 6 -10he instructs them to do four things. 1) Speak truth to your neighbor; 2) Execute truth and peacein your gates; 3) Do not imagine evil in your hearts against your neighbor; and 4) Do not love a false oath. It is important for us to remember the Lord's blessings upon His people were conditional upon their willingness to live according to His instructions and will. The application here for us is that we are not only to be truthful in our dealings, but we are also to speak the Lord's truth to all with whom come into contact. We are to speak the truth but we are to do so with love (Ephesians 4:15) and always with graceful speech, seasoned with salt (Colossians 4:6).

Second, as a family, church, and community we need to execute the truth of the Lord in our lives with love for God, love for ourselves, love for each other, and love for the lost (John 13:34; Mark 12:30–31). We must allow the peace that comes from God to dictate what we do and say and not the lies of worldliness and evil.

Third, we need to remember that all these things begin within our hearts (Matthew 12:34 –35; Philippians 4:8). And we should always assume the best of each other and consider the needs and desires of others more important than our own (Philippian 2:3).

And lastly, we need to love telling truth and doing what we say we will do. The Psalmist asks and answers, "In whose eyes a vile person is despised, but he honors those who fear the LORD; He who swears to his own hurt and does not change" (Psalm 15:4)

Ensure God's blessings today by being obedient and faithful.
