Come, Lord Jesus, Again



In Revelation 20:5–6 John pens that "Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection (baptism). Over such the second death (judgment) has no power." Yet those who do not, and do not have their names found written in the "Book of Life," will be cast into the lake of fire (vs.15)

Then, in chapter 21, John gets to see a glimpse of the church in its ultimate glory: as a beautiful bride adorned for her husband, as a great city whose walls keep and protect all who enter, and a magnificent garden that gives way to the tree of life. To all this John is told, "blessed is he that keeps the sayings of the prophecy of this book...that do his commands, that they might have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city." Having seen all these things John replies, "Amen, Even so, come, Lord Jesus."

One of the most important aspects of life is to come to terms with our own mortality. The fact that this life is as temporary as a vapor (James 4:14). But there is an eternity that awaits us when this life is over. Jesus, went to the cross to prepare a place for us (John 14:2–3) and He is coming again to take home those who have obeyed and remained faithful.
