OUR WEEKLY FOCUS

BY WHAT AUTHORITY

Peter and John went up to the temple in Acts 3 and saw a certain man, lame from birth, sitting at the gate called Beautiful. This man was asking for alms from those that passed by. He did ask for alms from Peter and John, but Peter asked the man to look at him. Peter then told him, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have to give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk." (Acts 3:6) This man immediately rose with his feet and anklebones full strength. This man "leaped up, stood and walked, walking, leaping and praising God". Peter then took opportunity to preach the gospel to those there who witnessed this miracle.

In chapter 4, the priest, captain of the temple, and the Sadducees came upon him and were upset and put him into custody. However, many believed Peter's word. The next day, rulers, elders, scribes, Annas the high priest, Caiaphas, John, and Alexander, and many of the high priest family were gathered at Jerusalem to hear Peter. Verse seven is the important question at hand "By what power (or authority) or by what name have you done this?"

Verse ten is the passage to draw attention to. "Let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole."

By what authority do we do things in religious matters today? Do we follow Colossians 3:17? Can we make the same statement that Peter made about our doctrinal beliefs, our steps of salvation and our practice of religious matters today? If not, why not?
