LIKE A TREE

And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper." (Psalm 1:3)

□ He is a beautiful, living creature. —His leaf also shall not wither. He retains his attractiveness, just like a tree holds its foliage. No ugly withering. Few objects in nature are as pleasing as a handsome tree. Its foliage beautifies the landscape. It crowns the hilltop. It touches up the mansion. But even more attractive is a righteous, fruit-bearing life. No mansion is pretty without it. How beautiful is a good life!
