

A Homecoming to Remember

Many families regularly celebrate a reunion by coming together for fun, fellowship, and rec-ollections. We can learn spiritual lessons from relationships and experiences here on earth. Con-sider the following homecoming realities of which being together for worship is a form:

We have many things in common though separated by miles. Those early Christians had all things in common (Acts 2:44). They were members of the same family - the church of the Lord, and shared a common salvation. They preached the same message, had a common life-style, and shared objectives for life. Their affection for each other was mutual.

Death has a way of interrupting our earthly ties. We are separated from many this very day who are awaiting judgment. Death was discussed by Paul as being inevitable, but eventually can be conquered (1 Cor. 15:51-57).

Some will abandon their family values. This was true with Alexander and Hymenaeus (1 Tim. 1:20). Hearts today are lured away from God by immorality, materialism, false teaching, etc. This awareness is never welcome, but a reality (1 Tim. 4:1-2).

It is a reminder that we really need one another. Those early Christians sought edification and encouragement in the association they enjoyed in Christ (1 Thess. 5:11). We know the pow-er of being home-sick and longing for loved ones today.

Another reality to be seriously pondered is the fact that time is fast fleeting. James said that life was like the "flowers of the grass" and a "vapor that disappears" (Jas. 1:10; 4:14). Urgency is shown throughout the Bible, saying in simple, "Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation" (2 Cor. 6:2b).

Our associations here need to be positive and worth remembering for whether we like it or not, they shall be remembered! The memories that we have of one another should be a joy for both parties involved in that remembrance.

Paul's prayer for the Ephesians is one which needs to be extended today to all who are God's children. He prayed for their strength, faith, love, comprehension of the love of Christ, and for Christ to be glorified through the church (Eph. 3:14-21). We need to have the mind of Abraham who looked for God's city, the heavenly city, prepared for His people (Heb. 11:10, 16; 12:22).
