The Mission of Jesus Christ: -Daniel Manning

Did you know that we are no longer waiting for Christ to accomplish His mission on this earth? Think back through your study of the New Testament and consider the message that John the Baptist proclaimed: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand..." (Matt. 3:1-3). It is incredible to read about the impact made on the Judean population from such a simple message. The message was received and obeyed with willing submission to God. Men and women were ready to return to the path of righteousness in anticipation of the coming of a promised Messiah—they were looking for a Savior (Isa. 9:6-7; Isa. 7:14).

The mission of Christ was never stated more clearly than from the very mouth of John when he said, "Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world." (John 1:29). Though John surely prepared the world for the mission of Christ through his message, it was Jesus who fulfilled the very words which John spoke concerning Himself. The statement John made, though small, is one of the most significant things ever proclaimed about Christ. It is no wonder, then, why Christ would say of John, "Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he." (Matt. 11:11).

Therefore, when I consider the proclamation made about Christ by this man who is so great, I get a sense of the importance of Christ's statement about the kingdom of heaven. If Christ never accomplished His mission, this kingdom proclaimed by John would still be awaiting arrival into this world. We believe there is significant proof suggesting the fact that Christ accomplished His mission while on this earth.

The mission of Christ is the very glue that holds together every account recorded in the Bible. Jesus' mission can be simplified down to the accomplishment of three major goals:

First, He came into the world to fulfill the promises of the Old Testament (Matt. 5:17; Rom. 10:4; Gal. 4:4-5). From the time sin entered the world, a promise was made to all of humanity that God would provide an ultimate way for salvation from the certainty of death (Gen. 3:13-17). Without Christ coming into this world, the promise of God would still not be fulfilled (Gen. 12:1-3; 1 Cor. 15:19).

The second goal of Christ's mission is equally important: He would destroy the enemy known as Satan (Heb. 2:14; 1 John 3:8). Just as man received a promise from God that they would have access to salvation, God made an opposite promise to the serpent in the garden that he would be defeated through the seed of a woman (Gen. 3:15-19). This promise is finally realized through the record of the lineage of Christ (Matt. 1:1-18; Ruth 4:4-5; Gen. 12:1-3).

Third, and finally, Christ would save mankind from their most hopeless situation—sin (Luke 19:10; 1 John 4:9-14; Matt. 18:11). The promises made in the Old Testament and the defeat of Satan through the seed line of Christ are both made possible through the same circumstances. He came into this world to save sinners; there was no other mission when He came to this earth. This mission was fulfilled with His death, burial, and resurrection (1 Cor. 15:1-3).

Surely, Jesus has completed His mission that He came here to accomplish. I am thankful to be a follower of Christ and part of His finished mission (Eph. 5:22-23).
